These include over 70 meat and sausage alternatives, 80 plant-based cheese alternatives, as well as a considerable number of unpackaged and innovative products such as vegan alternatives to salmon, sushi, and bacon. We also offer loose products in a practical filling station, such as beans, hemp seeds, muesli, etc. We make it easy for you to reach into the shelves to your heart's content without having to study the list of ingredients beforehand.

As a special service for you, our Veganz stores offer:

- More than 120 Veganz items from snacks like Bliss Balls and waffle slices, to savoury items like hemp spreads and our fish alternatives Smoked Salmon and Sea Style Sticks, to sweet and savoury snacks like Choc Bars, vegan bars, and crackers.
- A total of over 2,500 purely vegan items, including over 70 meat and sausage alternatives from well-known brands such as Tofurky, Vegini, Planty of Meat and Fry's, as well as 80 plant-based cheese alternatives from Veganz, Gondino, NaturWunderbar, and Simply V, for example.
- In Prenzlauer Berg, you'll find a brand-new fresh food counter with vegan sausage and cheese specialties, gourmet foods and sandwiches, lunch and breakfast bowls, and crusty rolls and bread from ZEIT FÜR BROT. There's also a SONETT self-filling station with vegan cleaning products such as hand soap, all-purpose cleaner, colour laundry detergent, and dishwashing liquid.

DearGoods clothing store

The creators of this sustainable clothing store love what they do and are always on the lookout for the latest trends and innovations that make the world a little more beautiful and fairer. DearGoods only sells products that come from fair production and fair trade. The team also goes one step further, because animal welfare and environmental protection are also very close to Dear-Goods' heart.

Therefore, clothing, accessories, and bags sold at Dear-Goods are as ecological as possible, vegan, and above all fair. The 3 hearts in the logo symbolise this – the love for animals, people, and the environment.

SauberKunst soap manufacturer

SauberKunst produces vegan, palm oil-free soaps with a focus on high-quality ingredients and handmade products that are a pleasure for the eyes and skin. Today, the product range includes not only vegan soaps, but also vegan cosmetics such as SheaMousse and CremeDeo, as well as solid shampoos - all packaged plastic-free, of course.

The vegan cheese manufactory from Veganz

The vegan cheese manufactory produces the new organic Veganz Cashewbert, a clean-label alternative for cashew-based Camembert. In-house production started at the end of September 2020 in Berlin Prenzlauer Berg right next to the first Veganz supermarket. The handmade cheese alternative with vegan starter cultures scores with a low carbon footprint and creates about 2/3 less CO₂ emissions per 175-gram package compared to its conventional counterpart.

The manufactory produces 10,000 cashew cheese wheels by hand every week. Demand from retailers is already significantly higher and a further production facility is being planned. Additional varieties of vegan cheese specialties will then be produced there, such as a purely plant-based blue cheese, as well as vegan fish and meat alternatives.
